



90% of Medicaid-funded child EBP providers reported continuing to see clients via telehealth

Telehealth Utilization

Pre and During Pandemic Comparison

There was a significant increase (almost 6,000%) in the number of members receiving a specialized behavioral health service through a telehealth platform, from <u>approximately 300 members per week in November (2019) compared to</u> <u>approximately 20K members per week in March (2020).</u>


There was a corresponding increase in the number of providers delivering services through telehealth platforms, with <u>approximately 40 providers per week in</u> <u>November (2019) to approximately 900 providers per week in March (2020)</u>. This represents over a 2,000% increase.



Eligibility Criteria:


Agencies <u>must be currently serving Medicaid-insured</u> <u>clients</u> for child/adolescent behavioral health treatment.

Practitioners must <u>be working towards certification (i.e.</u> <u>trained or currently in training) or certified</u> in one of the evidence-based practices from the LA Medicaid "menu."
